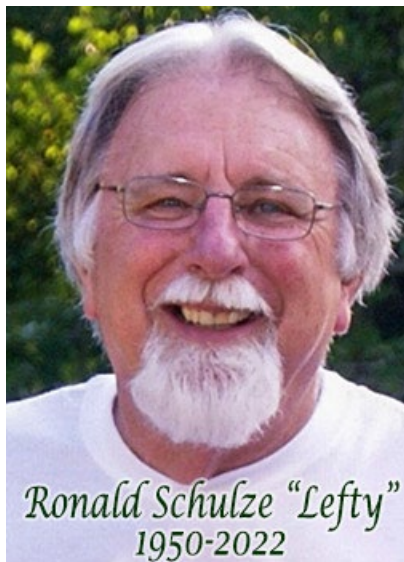


# RONALD SCHULZE
